**Up to \$7500 Available for Exhibits Curated by  
Cultural and Heritage Organizations in Oregon**

**Salem, Ore.** – The Oregon State Capitol has long displayed exhibits from entities throughout the state. The Capitol History Gateway (CHG) Program allows storytelling in “the People’s Building” through revolving exhibits that are curated through vetted cultural and heritage museums and organizations. Historically those exhibits have been displayed physically at the Capitol, but for the past two years exhibits have been featured digitally on [www.oregoncapitol.com](http://www.oregoncapitol.com).

To help aid organizations tell their stories, the Oregon State Capitol Foundation (OSCF), who helps fund the CHG, has offered to financially support the curation of exhibits for up to \$7500 per organization.

The Capitol’s Visitor Services Department produces the CHG program, including events and exhibits, and will be administrating this funding opportunity.
